1. Media Accreditation



Please apply for Media AD Pass those who wish to cover NTN presents 20th Tour of Japan

- (1) Registration from following URL: https://goo.gl/forms/W7apeNKLOZzyiIdK2
- (2) Once the registration has been accepted, please come to the press registration tent located at each stage on the race day. You will be asked to submit your name card as your identification. Please be aware that location and open hour for registration varies in stages.
- (3) The registration may be rejected depending on the content of application. Media AD Pass shall be invalidated in case of any dangerous act or violation has been found.
- (4) AD pass will be distributed to journalist, writer, and commentator. It is not required to return the pass after the race. A bib will be distributed to photographer and TV cameraman and this must be returned to TOJ Press Official after the race. The person may be charged in case of lost or unreturned bib.
 - (5) The latest stage map can be downloaded from the official website (www.toj.co.jp/2017)
 - (6) Please wear the AD pass so that it is visible.

2. Media Tent

Media tent is located at the finish area of each stages. The open hour is 30 minutes before race start to 30 minutes after the race finish.

3. Internet and Other Technologies

WIFI service is available inside the media tent. However, please be aware that there may be cases of weak signals or slow speed service in some areas. There is no FAX machine or printers available. Also 100V electronic power supply may not be available in all stages.

4. Parking Area

There is no parking area for media relations. Please use the closest public parking or temporary parking. Please be noted that in some stages you may not move through the start or finish area due to the traffic regulation.

5. AD Pass Control

Media AD pass and bibs have limited access to certain areas. Please follow the instructions indicated in each venues.

▲There may be capacity limit for each area

6. Coverage Regulation

No coverage, photo, or filming is permitted in license control, team manager's meeting, driver's meeting, commissaire meeting.

All person other than official TV/photo should evacuate from the start area by 3 minutes before the start.

In finish area, only person wearing the bibs assigned by TOJ can enter the designated area away from the finish line. However, depending on the race situation the area may be separated into several areas or those with no experience in cycle road race may be restricted to enter the area. Please follow the instruction of TOJ Press Official.

7. Award Ceremony/Interview

At each stages, there will be award ceremonies for stage winner and each classification winners.

Medias should be inside the designated area during the ceremonies. Interview and photo shoot should be done immediately after the award ceremony at the back stage or inside the awarding tent. There will be no interview at the press tent.
